

DOG POLICY

With many great walks and miles of sandy beaches nearby, dogs are very welcome at Heacham Manor.

We offer a selection of Dog Friendly Family Suites at Heacham Manor. These are part of our Family Suite range and are located on the ground floor of the Norfolk style cottages, just a few metres adjacent to the Manor House.

Please take a moment to read our Terms and Conditions:

1. There is a £10 charge per dog, per night.
2. A maximum of 2 well behaved dogs are allowed in the designated Family Suites. We do not allow any dogs listed in the Dangerous Dog Act 1991.
3. Dogs are welcome to relax with you on the Manor Bar terrace or on the ground floor Pavilion terrace, however they are not permitted in the Mulberry Restaurant, Manor Bar or Pavilion. Room service is available in your accommodation (which is equipped with a dining table and chairs) so that you can all enjoy a family meal together.
4. Dogs are not permitted in the Manor House, including the lounge, or sitting areas, except for guide dogs and certified assistance dogs.
5. To access the beach, you are welcome to walk your dog across the golf course using the designated path. Dogs must always be kept on a lead whilst crossing the course, and please be vigilant due to the risk of flying golf balls.
6. Please clear up after your dog and use the black bins located in the green shed next to the Avocet Barn.
7. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times whilst on the property.
8. No dogs are to be left alone in a car parked on the property.
9. All dogs must sleep in their own dog bed, and we ask you not to allow your dog onto the furniture or beds in your accommodation.
10. Any disturbances such as barking must be curtailed to ensure other guests are not inconvenienced, and customers will be liable for any damage caused.
11. We ask that you supply us with a mobile telephone number on your booking just in case we need to contact you in an emergency. This is particularly useful if you plan on leaving your dog alone in your suite at any point during your stay – understandably, they can get a bit fed up and unsettled when they are left alone in a new place!
